Activities of Gau Mahima Seva Trust during 2018 are as under:

1. The Vice- Chancellor of Pt Deen Dayal Upadhyay Veterinary and Animal Science University (DUVASU) invited Dr RS Chauhan to deliver an expert lecture on “Current Scenario of Chemical Farming and Road Map of Rural Development- The Indian Cow Model” in MANAGE Sponsored Training programme on Capacity Building of Extension Functionaries for Promotion of Entrepreneurship among Farmers, on January 1, 2018, DUVASU Mathura. Dr Chauhan was the chief guest of the inaugural function and addressed the gathering. His work on cowpathy was very much appreciated specially in the context of rural entrepreneurship development.

2. Committee for the Purpose of Control and Supervision of Experiments in Animals (CPCSEA) Government of India, constituted its central committee through a gazette notification and made Dr RS Chauhan chairman of the Go Mahima Seva Trust as its expert member. He was also made member and chairman of several sub-committees specially for preparing the guidelines on the “Reuse and Rehabilitation of large animals” to facilitate the smooth functioning of the CPCSEA.

3. Anticancer properties of indigenous cow urine was established through experiments in vitro in cell cultures and in vivo in rats under the able guidance of Dr RS Chauhan and the findings of this research in the Journal of Immunology and Immunopathology.

4. Dr RS Chauhan chairman of Go Mahima Seva Trust, delivered several lectures on A1 and A2 milk, their advantages and disadvantages with respect to the indigenous cows, cross bred and exotic cows.
